PHYSICAL EDUCATION: All students need **sneakers** for every class (tie and Velcro® are best). A **sweatshirt** (to be left in their classroom lockers) is best for spring and fall when we go outside.

4th and 5th graders need a **change of clothes** (a shirt and shorts—sweats allowed for cold days outside). Clothes must be kept in some sort of gym bag. All **spray** deodorant, perfume, and other sprays are not allowed at any time in school. Deodorant should be applied in the morning at home and the children may bring a stick deodorant in their gym bag to re-apply in the locker room as needed.
