Where do our funds and supplies come from?

Our all volunteer staff is greatly aided by the generous folks of Grand Island who provide donations to us, particularly at the Holiday Season thru our Share Your Happiness fund raising campaign. Grand Island organizations and businesses have favored us with many donations throughout the year, but we can always use more funds.

Non-perishable food is held at a pantry in space generously supplied by St. Stephens Church on Baseline Rd. That food comes from donations GI Post Office Letter Carriers bring us from their yearly 'Stamp Out Hunger' drive and a G I Schools food drive at the Holiday Season, supplemented with food collected by Scout, dance and other youth groups.

Funds are used to buy extra food that is occasionally needed in pantry and to purchase Tops and Dollar Tree Gift Cards we supply to clients to allow them to purchase perishables. Target and other store Gift Cards are donated to us, or purchased, to provide 'a little something extra' to children of clients at Holiday time.
