

The verbal description of the movement of letter formation:

Movement should begin as large, bold movements and then become minimal--model the movements vertically in the air guiding the child's hand and then on the chalkboard. Always say the letter name after formation. Be sure that the action is done at the same time you and the child are orally saying the movement. Then, transfer the oral part to just the child saying it. Insist on coordination of speech and movement. GB pg. 40
