The PTA is proud to offer an opportunity for creativity and fun. The National PTA Reflections Program is a national arts recognition and achievement open to all students in pre-school through grade12 in the areas of literature, musical composition, photography, visual arts, dance choreography, and film production. The works of art will be blindly judged by professionals in the respective arts areas, and selected works will be advanced to the Niagara Region PTA. From that point, selected works will advance to the state or national levels for judging. This year the theme is "Believe, Dream, Inspire". Works must be original and created by the student.

There are no limits on how many entries a student may submit. However, only two works in each category can be selected to go on to the Niagara Region PTA judging. An additional two works in all categories are allowed from eligible special education students. All submissions must have a completed student entry form with the work. Please make sure to also fill out the artist statement: at least 10 words with a maximum of 100 words.
